ORDER AMENDING LONG-TERM AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 429-A

Salmon Resources Ltd. (Salmon) is authorized by DOE/FE Order No. 429 (Order 429), FE 70,357, to import up to 15,700 MMBtu per day of natural gas from Canada in accordance with a gas purchase agreement with Shell Canada Limited (Shell). This natural gas is being resold to Cogen Energy Technology Inc. (CETI) as fuel for its combined-cycle cogeneration facility in Castleton-on-Hudson, New York. The term of the authorization is for twenty years, beginning on November 1, 1991, and ending on August 31, 2011.

On January 16, 1996, Salmon informed the Department of Energy that, in order to stream-line its operation, it will assign its interest in the Salmon-CETI contract to Shell and terminate its Shell contract. Salmon has requested that its authorization in Order 429 be transferred to Cogen Energy

Technology L.P. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the
Natural Gas Act, the authorization granted to Salmon by Order 429

is amended to substitute Cogen Energy Technology L.P. for Salmon Resources Ltd. as the importer of natural gas. Further, in all other respects, Order 429 shall remain in full force and effect.
