ORDER AMENDING AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT
NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 822-A

On July 16, 1993, the Department of Energy (DOE) granted long-term authorization to The Washington Water Power Company in DOE/FE Order No. 822 (Order 822)^{1/} to import at Kingsgate, British Columbia (B.C.), up to 61,400 Mcf per day of Canadian natural gas over a period of ten years beginning on the date of the first delivery. First delivery occurred November 1, 1993. On March 1, 1999, Avista Corporation filed an application to amend Order 822 to reflect a name change from The Washington Water Power Company to Avista Corporation.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 822 is amended to substitute Avista Corporation for The Washington Water Power Company as the importer of

natural gas. All terms and conditions in Order 822 remain in full force and effect.
