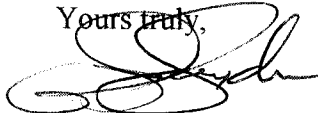

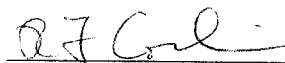
ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO
IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS
FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1076-A

On August 10, 1995, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Brymore Energy Inc. (Brymore) in DOE/FE Order No. 1076 (Order 1076) (2 FE ¶ 71,149) to import and export up to a combined total of 200 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term. On January 5, 2005, Brymore Energy Inc. filed a request to vacate Order 1076.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 1076, authorizing the import and export of natural gas from and to Canada, is hereby vacated, effective on the date of this Order.
