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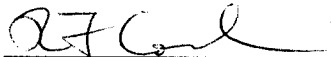
ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO MEXICO

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 825-A

On July 30, 1993, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company (Tennessee) in DOE/FE Order No. 825 (Order 825) (1 FE ¶70,823) to export up to 100 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas to Mexico over a two-year term beginning on the date of the first delivery. Exports have not begun under the authorization. On December 20, 2005, DOE was notified that Tennessee does not intend to export natural gas to Mexico and no longer needs its authorization. Tennessee has requested that DOE vacate Order No. 825.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 825, authorizing the export of natural gas to Mexico, is hereby vacated.
