ORDER VACATING LONG-TERM AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 736-A

On November 25, 1992, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted long-term authorization to Encogen Northwest, L.P. (Encogen) in DOE/FE Order No. 736 (Order 736) (1 FE ¶70,716) to import up to 9,579 Mcf of natural gas per day from Canada beginning on January 1, 1993, and continuing for 15 years following the commencement of commercial operation of Encogen's Bellingham Washington cogeneration facility.

On March 21, 2006, Puget Sound Energy (PSE) notified DOE that Encogen had been purchased by PSE and no longer exists as an entity. Encogen does not need its current authorization and requests that DOE vacate Order 736.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 736, authorizing the import of natural gas from Canada, is hereby vacated.
