ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2088-A

On April 27, 2005, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Dartmouth Power Associates Limited Partnership (Dartmouth) in DOE/FE Order No. 2088 (Order 2088) (2 FE ¶71,108) to import up to 11.68 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from Canada over a two-year term beginning on May 7, 2005, and extending through May 6, 2007. On February 14, 2006, DOE was notified that Dartmouth is not currently engaged in the import of natural gas and no longer needs its authorization. Dartmouth has requested that DOE vacate Order 2088.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 2088, authorizing the import of natural gas from Canada, is hereby vacated.
