ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2101-A

On June 10, 2005, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Transco Energy Marketing Company (TEMCO) in DOE/FE Order No. 2101 (Order 2101) (2 FE ¶71,136) to import up to 730 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from Canada over a two-year term beginning on February 7, 2005, and extending through February 6, 2007. On June 15, 2006, DOE was notified that TEMCO no longer needs its authorization and has requested that DOE vacate Order 2101.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 2101, authorizing the import of natural gas from Canada, is hereby vacated.
