Dear Mr. Anderson:

On June 6, Carib Energy (USA) LLC ("Carib") filed an Application for Long-Term Authorization to Export Liquefied Natural Gas to Free Trade Agreement Countries ("Application"). Carib is hereby submitting an amendment to the Application.

First, Carib amends the Application to clarify that the volume of natural gas it seeks to export is approximately 11.53 billion standard cubic feet ("bscf") per year. This volume would include both exports to countries located within South America, Central America or the Caribbean with which the United States has free trade agreements requiring national treatment for trade in natural gas and LNG ("FTA"), and exports to countries within South America, Central America or the Caribbean with which the United States does not have an FTA requiring national treatment for trade in natural gas and LNG. As noted in the Application, the application for long-term exports of LNG to non-FTA countries will be filed separately at a later date.

Second, Carib amends the Application to provide that Carib's mode of transportation for LNG under the authorization sought through the Application will be limited to approved ISO IMO7/TVAC-ASME LNG containers.
